

Riverside Secondary School 2024 Direct School Admission Information (For admission to Secondary One in 2025)

A. INTRODUCTION

The Direct School Admission Exercise (DSA) allows students to seek admission to Riverside Secondary School based on a range of achievements and talents.

Students who have excellent leadership skills or specific academic talents, may apply for DSA under the following talent areas:

- Leadership and Character
- Tamil Language

Students who are talented in one of the five Co-Curricular Activities (CCA) may apply for DSA under the Performing Arts, Media or STEM:

- Choir
- Concert Band
- Media
- STEM (Robotics Club or Environmental Science Club)

Selection is based on the following:

Talent in one of the areas stipulated by the school, as evidenced by past achievements in the area of talent and a talent assessment, for shortlisted applicants. The talent assessments are:

- CCA audition and interview
- Specific academic talent written assessment and interview
- Leadership interview

Qualification(s) in robotics/programming (Lego EV3, Mindstorms, Spike Prime), e.g., relevant certificates (if any). Accomplishment - Evidence in the form of awards or experiences in relevant contexts such as STEM competitions or projects in school/external events (if any). Please note that meeting all the criteria does not guarantee the student will be shortlisted/given an offer.

Applicants who do not have prior experience may also apply. The school will assess applicants based on the selection criteria, which may include assessing the potential of the applicants.

C. APPLICATION PROCESS

	Apply through the centralised DSA-Sec Portal.
	Eligibility i. Applicants from MOE mainstream primary schools: Parent may log in directly to DSA-Sec Portal. Only one parent's Singpass is required. Parents/ guardians who are unable to apply online can approach their child's primary school for assistance.
Application	ii. Other applicants <u>not</u> studying in MOE mainstream primary schools: Students need to apply for a Registration Number
(7 May - 3 Jun 2024)	(RGxxxxxxx) to access the DSA-Sec Portal. Please refer to MOE website at: https://go.gov.sg/nmsdsa-sec-application .
	All shortlisted International Students who are <u>not</u> taking PSLE are required to take and fulfil the requirements of the Admissions Exercise for International Students test to be successful in DSA.
	Choices. Students can indicate up to three choices (maximum of two choices for the same school under two different talent areas).
	Shortlisted applicants will be notified via email on the details of their audition and interview by 19 July 2024. Applicants who are not shortlisted will also be informed via email that they are unsuccessful in their application.
	 Interview panel would be looking out for: For Performing Arts / Media applicants, candidates are expected to demonstrate their chosen arts ability / potential during the audition. Candidates are also expected to share their Performing Arts / Media experiences during the interview.
Auditions / Interviews	 For Tamil Language, each shortlisted applicant will submit a written work. Candidates are also expected to demonstrate their
(26 Jul - 16 Aug 2024)	competencies in the Tamil Language through an interview discussion component.
	- For Leadership and Character applicants, the focus of the interview is to ascertain students' motivation and leadership dispositions as well as to look out for social-emotional competencies.

	 Interview panel would also be looking for evidence of positive attitude and commitment through conversations with the candidate. 	
	 Applicants who do not attend auditions / interviews without informing the school prior, will forfeit their places and be disqualified.
